Permit Description: P.H. Glatfelter is requesting an Administrative Modification to include requirements regarding Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) for emissions units B002 - No. 7 Coal Boiler, and B003 - No. 8 Coal Boiler.

Chris Korleski, Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, 50 West Town Street, Columbus Ohio, has issued a draft action of an air pollution control permit-to-install (PTI) for an air contaminant source at the location identified above on the date indicated. USEPA's 1999 Regional Haze rule requires Ohio to have additional controls for certain sources that contribute to visibility impairment in Class I areas. The purpose of this administrative modification is to fulfill this requirement by incorporating BART to reduce emissions of sulfur dioxide from P.H. Glatfelter's two coal-fired boilers. Glatfelter will be implementing an alternative program to BART as allowed under 40 CFR 51.308(e)(2). An alternative BART measure must achieve greater reasonable progress than would be achieved through the installation and operation of traditional BART. The sulfur dioxide requirements being incorporated into this permit constitute a reduction in sulfur dioxide emissions of more than ninety percent compared to the concentrations emitted for which P.H. Glatfelter was determined to contribute to visibility impairment. Once finalized, the BART requirements will be federally enforceable and incorporated into Ohio's final Regional Haze State Implementation Plan (SIP). Pursuant to Part C, Subpart 2, of Title I of the Clean Air Act, Ohio EPA is required to establish a SIP to address Ohio's impact on visibility in Class I areas. The above-mentioned BART requirements are a part of Ohio's SIP and the draft administrative modification will be submitted to USEPA as a modification of the SIP. The abovementioned hearing shall be considered the public hearing for this portion of the SIP submittal. Comments concerning this draft action, or a request for a public meeting, must be sent in writing no later than thirty (30) days from the date this notice is published.
