

RULE SYNOPSIS

Draft rule language for Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-103 Acid Rain Permits and Compliance – 5 Year Review

The Ohio EPA Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has completed draft rule language for OAC Chapter 3745-103. The draft amendments are being made as a result of the 5 year review of the rules as required in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 106.03 and 106.031. A draft of amended rules was released to interested parties for a 30-day comment period ending July 11, 2017. No comments were received. Minor editorial changes were made based on further internal review. The following changes to this chapter are being proposed:

1. Minor Amendments:

Ohio EPA is making minor amendments to 51 rules (OAC rules 3745-103-01 to -09, -11 to -22, -24, -26 to -29, -31 to -35, and -42 to -45, -47 to -48, -51 to -53, -55 to -63 and -65 to -66) to ensure equivalency with the federal equivalent, correct cross-references and typographical errors, and conform with agency formatting standards. These changes are minor in nature, and do not affect the scope or intent of the rules.

2. No Changes Necessary:

Ohio EPA also finds that the following eight rules, included in this rulemaking package, are necessary, but without need of change: OAC rules 3745-103-23, -25, -36 to -39, -41, and -50.
