

RULE SYNOPSIS

5 Year Review of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 3745-76

"Control of Non-methane Organic Compound (NMOC) Emissions From Existing Landfills"

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has completed the five- year review of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) chapter 3745-76. This chapter is related to regulations for the control of non-methane organic compounds (NMCO) for Municipal Solid Waste Landfills. DAPC has determined that two of the rules in this chapter are necessary and in need of minor changes; OAC rules 3745-76-01 and 3745-76-10. DAPC also determined that the remaining rules in the chapter, OAC rules 3745-76-(02 – 04, 06-09, and 11-15) remain necessary and are without need of changes. The "No-change" rules were filed with the Joint Committee on Agency Review (JCARR) on March 24, 2016. DAPC is proposing the following amendments to the rules in this chapter:

OAC Rule 3745-76-01, "Definitions"

DAPC is updating information on the version and availability of items referenced in this chapter. Specifically, Ohio EPA is updating the intro paragraph, and several sub paragraphs under paragraph (8)(31) of this rule to update these materials.

OAC Rule 3745-76-10, "Compliance Provisions"

DAPC is making a change to the intro paragraph to better identify the location of information on the version and availability of items referenced in this chapter. Ohio EPA is also making a change to update a citation in paragraph (8)(2) of this rule. The citation should be to paragraph (D) of OAC rule 3745-76-08, not paragraph (O) of OAC 3745-76-12 as it currently reads.
