Dear Ms. Patton:

Holly's Café & Carry Out public water system (PWS) has violated Ohio's safe drinking water law. Specifically, the PWS has failed to monitor for total coliform and nitrate, failed to issue public notices, and failed to submit payment for the PWS's 2011 license to operate (LTO).

Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.33.

To resolve your drinking water violations and avoid possible legal action and civil penalties, it is agreed that Holly's Café & Carry Out will:

1. Comply with total coliform bacteria monitoring and maximum contaminant level (MCL) requirements, in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-81-21 and 3745-81-14, respectively.
2. Comply with nitrate monitoring requirements, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-23(B).
3. Comply with all current and future contaminant monitoring schedules issued by the Director.
4. Comply with all public notification requirements associated with any future monitoring and MCL violations, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32.
5. Within sixty (60) days, submit verification to "Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Central Office, Lazarus Government Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, Attn: Laura Webb," that payment or arrangement of a payment plan has been made with the Attorney General's Office, Collections Enforcement Section (888-246-0688), 150 E. Gay Street, 21st Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, for the unpaid 2011 LTO (Ohio EPA Revenue ID: K-782585/AGO Account # 10111624).
6. Timely submit a complete application along with the appropriate fee for a LTO annually, for each year that the PWS is in operation, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-84-03.

7. Correct the improper well extension by replacing the PVC pipe with a like material to that of the original casing and completing the extension's installation, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-9-05(N).
