PREAMBLE

It is agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

These Director's Findings and Orders (Orders) are issued to Scott R. Matola (Respondent) pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6109 and § 3745.01.

II. PARTIES BOUND

These Orders shall apply to and be binding upon Respondent.

III. DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise stated, all terms used in these Orders shall have the same meaning as defined in ORC Chapter 6109 and the rules promulgated thereunder.

IV. FINDINGS

The Director of Ohio EPA (Director) has determined the following findings:

1. In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-7-07, Respondent has passed the Class A Water Supply examination and was designated as a Class A Water Supply operator in training until he fulfilled the onsite operating experience requirements.
2. Respondent took the Class A Wastewater examination on November 2, 2011.
3. A review of Ohio EPA records indicates Respondent failed to submit an application or examination fee for the November 2, 2011 examination.

13. Respondent's use of a falsified examination entrance letter to gain entry to the examination constitutes the knowing submission of false documents to Ohio EPA pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-7-12(A)(3).

V. ORDERS

1. Upon the effective date of these Orders, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-18(A), Respondent's Class A Wastewater examination scores are declared invalid.
2. Upon the effective date of these Orders, Respondent's designation as a Class A Water Supply operator in training shall be withdrawn.
3. Upon the effective date of these Orders, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-18(A)(2), Respondent shall be disqualified from taking future Water Supply and Wastewater examinations for a period of five years.

VI. TERMINATION

Respondent's obligations under these Orders shall terminate five years from the effective date of these Orders.

VII. OTHER CLAIMS

Nothing in these Orders shall constitute or be construed as a release from any claim, cause of action or demand in law or equity against any person, firm, partnership or corporation, not a party to these Orders, for any liability arising from, or related to the Respondent.

VIII. OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS

All actions required to be taken pursuant to these Orders shall be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations. These Orders do not waive or compromise the applicability and enforcement of any other statutes or regulations applicable to Respondent.

IX. MODIFICATIONS


These Orders may be modified by agreement of the parties. Modifications shall be in writing and shall be effective on the date entered in the journal of the Director of Ohio EPA.
