Chapter 3745-87 and Rule 3745-95-09 of the Ohio Administrative Code.**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) is proposing 'no changes' to Chapter 3745-87 and rule 3745-95-09 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The proposed rule filing with 'no changes' is, in part, a result of the five-year rule review requirements of Section 106.031 of the Revised Code.
