
## History – Continued

- ▶ An incinerator was built in the mid-60's and operated until 1973.
- ▶ A Transfer Station was built by the county and finished in 1998.
- ▶ The old landfill has been overseen by the BIEC Committee and remediation has been ongoing since its closure.


## Layout of Department

- ▶ Population–103,640

# Miami County Solid Waste District

## Transfer Station

- ▶ Transfer Station is owned by the county
  - ▶ Open from 4 am for commercial accounts to 6 pm
  - ▶ Currently have seven employees in the transfer station and two scales operators
  - ▶ Have one inbound and two outbound scales
  - ▶ Commercial accounts can be fully automated
  - ▶ Enforce Flow Control on MSW

- ▶ Baler for cardboard and cans
- ▶ Paint program
- ▶ Lead acid batteries
- ▶ Propane tanks



# Miami County Solid Waste District

## Transfer Station

- ▶ Wood Waste
  - ▶ Tires
  - ▶ Scrap Metal
  - ▶ Blue Bag Program
  - ▶ Tipping Fee is \$59.05 (includes OEPA fee) – minimum fee is ~ \$6.00
  - ▶ No Generation or Tier fees

- ▶ Glass
- ▶ Cardboard
