**RE: Closed Oxford Sanitary Landfill, Butler County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Dreisbach,

On May 4, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received a request to update background in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g). This request was included in a revised statistical plan titled "*Statistical Analysis Program for Ground-Water Quality Monitoring Oxford Sanitary Landfill, Butler County, Ohio, Revision 3*". This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc. (EAI), on behalf of City of Oxford.

The facility has requested approval to update background groundwater data for monitoring well MW-9. Pursuant to Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the Director.

The Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) has reviewed the proposal and concurs that sodium and chloride concentrations in well MW-9 are attributed to natural variability in the ground water. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule


3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the Facility is authorized to add data from November 2007 through July 2009 (more than four data points) to the background data set in well MW-9.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
