**Re: County Environmental Landfill of Wyandot, Wyandot County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Traub:

On November 17, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document titled "County Environmental of Wyandot Landfill Wyandot County Response to Ohio EPA Comments dated August 2, 2010 Regarding Statistical Analysis Program for Ground Water Monitoring – Revision 7 OAC 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Request for Directors approval to Update with Statistically Significant Results OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(h) Intrawell Demonstration for Cobalt in SW-12," dated November 17, 2010, for the County Environmental Landfill of Wyandot (Facility). This document was submitted by Eagon and Associates, Inc., on behalf of the owner/operator. The submittal contained a request to add previously determined statistically significant increases to the background data base relative to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g). The data associated with the request for director's approval is for cobalt at well SW-12.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can only be added in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable by the director.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the information provided and concurs that this data can be added to the background data group. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to update the background database for cobalt at well SW-12 as detailed in the November 17, 2010 request.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action.

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The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
