**Re: Noble Road Landfill, Richland County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Green:

On May 4, 2011, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document titled "Response to Ohio EPA Letter Dated January 7, 2011 Noble Road Landfill", dated April 29, 2011, for Noble Road Landfill (Facility). This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc. on behalf of the owner/operator. The submittal contained a request to add previously-determined statistically significant increases to the background database pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g). The data included in this approval includes the following parameters/wells: chloride in BW-15 on May 1, 2007, and November 5, 2007; and ammonia in MW-1 on November 4, 2008, and May 12, 2009. All other wells and parameters contained in the request will be addressed in a separate letter.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can only be added in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable by the director.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the information provided and concurs that the data listed above is acceptable relative to updating the background data set.

Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner/operator is hereby authorized to update the background database for chloride in BW-15 on May 1, 2007, and November 5, 2007; and ammonia in MW-1 on November 4, 2008, and May 12, 2009.

A detailed account of Ohio EPA's review of the ground water demonstration will be sent to you under separate cover.



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You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
