

This permit is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.



PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a FINAL permit-to-install ("PTI" application number 781194) which authorizes establishment of the Universal Disposal, Inc. Solid Waste Transfer Facility ("Transfer Facility"), a proposed new solid waste transfer facility located at 9954 Old State Road, Chardon, Ohio 44024 in Geauga County. Universal Disposal, Inc. ("Applicant") is the proposed operator and the PTI applicant. PTI application number 781194 was received by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") on October 25, 2010, with the most recent revision received on April 20, 2011.

The proposed Transfer Facility is currently operating under a regulatory exemption as described in OAC Rule 3745-27-03(A)(11) because the existing facility consists solely of portable containers with an aggregate volume of fifty (50) cubic yards or less. The Applicant proposes to increase the aggregate volume of the portable containers used to collect, compact, and transfer solid wastes at the Transfer Facility to greater than fifty (50) cubic yards. The Transfer Facility is designed in accordance with the current solid waste transfer facility requirements.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached PTI.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio EPA ("Director"), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The proposed Transfer Facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the application for this permit approval. There may be no deviation from the approved plans without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved plans or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed Transfer Facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste transfer facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.
3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.

4. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI application number 781194 received October 25, 2010 and revised through April 20, 2011.
5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Transfer Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
7. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
8. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires for transfer to a disposal facility unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27, or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.
11. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste for transfer to a disposal facility unless source separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
12. The permittee shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance:
 - a. The permittee shall provide for daily inspection of the Transfer Facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures

employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA or the Geauga County Health District upon request.

- b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected and maintained to prevent blockage or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.
13. Not later than thirty (30) days after permit issuance, Universal Disposal, Inc. shall post clear instructions for using the Transfer Facility and maintain the instructions in legible condition, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(G)(1) through (4). All other site preparation, and other actions required by OAC Chapter 3745-27 for the Transfer Facility, shall be complete so that the facility is adequately prepared for the operations proposed in this permit.
14. Not later than thirty (30) days after permit issuance, the permittee shall execute and fund a financial assurance instrument meeting the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17.
15. Not later than forty-five (45) days after permit issuance, the permittee shall send verification to Ohio EPA-Northeast District Office (NEDO) and the Geauga County Health District that Condition Number 13 and Condition Number 14 have been met.
