**RE: Countywide Recycling and Disposal Facility, Stark County
Salvaging Operations Approval**

Dear Mr. Vandersall:

On July 13, 2011, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Northeast District Office (NEDO), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM) received a request to conduct salvaging of recyclable materials at the working face at Countywide Recycling and Disposal Facility (Countywide RDF) located in Stark County, Ohio.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-01(S)(1) defines salvaging as extracting or removing materials from the solid waste stream at the working face of a solid waste disposal facility for the intended purpose of recycling or for removal to a salvage facility. Also, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-19(E)(4), an owner or operator may only conduct salvaging in a manner approved by the Director of Ohio EPA (Director).

Ohio EPA has reviewed the request, dated July 13, 2011, to conduct salvaging from the solid waste stream at the working face of Countywide RDF. The request is hereby approved with the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. Salvaging operations shall only be conducted in accordance with the request dated July 13, 2011.
2. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-19(F), the owner or operator shall cover the roll-off boxes before the end of the working day to control fire hazards, blowing litter, odors, dust, insects, and rodents.
3. If conditions resulting from the salvaging of recyclables from the working face

results in the citation of a notice of violation by Ohio EPA or the Stark County Health Department of any requirement of OAC Rule 3745-27-19 or any other applicable regulation, the owner or operator shall immediately cease all salvaging operations.

4. If, in the judgment of Ohio EPA or the Stark County Health Department, the owner or operator is unable to abate existing nuisance conditions or has not complied with the conditions of this authorization, then the owner or operator shall, upon notification from Ohio EPA or Stark County Health Department, cease salvaging operations at Countywide RDF.
5. This approval authorizes the owner or operator to salvage only recyclable materials from only the working face of Countywide RDF. No additional salvaging operations may take place without prior authorization in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-19(E)(4).
6. Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

END OF CONDITIONS

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
