The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-02 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules and standards. All construction must be supervised by an engineer or expert qualified in such work. Because the permit approval contains conditions of compliance, I urge you to read it carefully.

You are requested to submit within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this Permit to Install, the required permit fee balance of twenty-one hundred dollars, \$2,100.00, payable to **Treasurer, State of Ohio**. Please send the required payments to:


Payment of the \$2,100.00 fee within 30 days is a requirement of ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V). Failure to timely submit the required permit fee will result in an assessment of late penalties.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the Appeals Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed at the following address:



The above-named entity is hereby issued a permit-to-install (permit) for the above-described source pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-02. Issuance of this permit does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3734.44, the applicant has exhibited sufficient reliability, expertise, and competency to operate the solid waste facility. This determination is made based upon review of the disclosure statements submitted pursuant to ORC Section 3734.42.

## PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a FINAL permit-to-install (PTI Number 778618) which authorizes establishment of the Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC, Akron Recyclery, (Transfer Facility), a proposed new solid waste transfer facility located at 964 Hazel Street, Akron, Ohio 44305 in Summit County. Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC is the proposed operator, landowner, and the PTI applicant. PTI application number 778618 was received on September 3, 2010, with the most recent revision received on August 23, 2011.

The proposed Transfer Facility is currently operating as a recycling facility and has an NPDES permit to discharge leachate to public sewers, where it is ultimately disposed in the City of Akron WWTP. Delivery trucks will deposit loads of commingled solid waste and recyclables at the direction of a ground spotter directly on the floor. Solid waste handling activities will be confined within the solid waste handling area, and the remaining space will continue to be used for handling recyclables. A compactor will compress waste into closed top roll-off containers for transport to an approved disposal facility. The financial assurance estimate for this PTI includes the removal and disposal of waste and leachate for the worst case scenario that waste fills the inside of the building. The Transfer Facility is designed in accordance with the current requirements.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit.

## PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The proposed Transfer Facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted which constitute this permit. There may be no deviation from the approved permit without the express, written approval of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA). Any deviation from the approved permit or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of this permit does not constitute an assurance that the proposed Transfer Facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste transfer facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.

3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI application number 778618 received September 3, 2010 and revised through August 23, 2011.
5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-02(l), this permit shall terminate three (3) years after its effective date if the permittee has not undertaken a continuing program of installation or has not entered into a binding contractual obligation to undertake and complete, within a reasonable time, a continuing program of installation of the Transfer Facility.
7. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Transfer Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
8. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
9. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M.
11. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires for transfer to a disposal facility unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27, or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.

12. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste for transfer to a disposal facility unless source separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
13. Ohio EPA-Northeast District Office (NEDO) and Summit County Health District shall receive written notification of the construction start date no later than seven (7) days prior to starting any construction authorized under this permit so that construction of the Transfer Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA-NEDO and Summit County Health District before being placed into operation.
14. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(Y), Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC shall not accept waste materials to any area of the Transfer Facility until all of the following events have occurred:
  - a. Site preparations for that area have been completed including:
    - i. The waste handling floor has been properly sealed;
    - ii. The leachate collection system has been properly constructed with secondary containment;
  - b. The certification report has been signed by the owner or operator and the certifying engineer stating that the Transfer Facility has been constructed in strict compliance with the applicable authorizing document and submitted to Ohio EPA;
  - c. The Transfer Facility has been adequately prepared for operation;
  - d. The prepared Transfer Facility has been inspected by Ohio EPA or the Summit County Health District.
15. The permittee shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance:
  - a. The permittee shall provide for daily inspection of the Transfer Facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA or the Summit County Health District upon request.
  - b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected and maintained to prevent blockage or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.

16. Prior to receipt of solid waste at the Transfer Facility, Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC shall post clear instructions for using the Transfer Facility and maintain the instructions in legible condition, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23 (G)(1) through (4), and shall complete all other site preparations and actions required by OAC Chapter 3745-27 so that the Transfer Facility is adequately prepared for the operations proposed in this permit to install.
17. Not later than thirty (30) days after permit issuance, the permittee shall execute and fund a financial assurance instrument meeting the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17.
