ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S  
MOTION FOR DEFAULT  
JUDGMENT

The Court finds Plaintiff State of Ohio's Motion for Default Judgment well taken. Plaintiff's Complaint was filed with this Court on February 26, 2003 and an Amended Complaint on March 6, 2003. Defendant Charles Farthing was served with the Amended Complaint on July 17, 2003. Defendant Farthing has failed to file an answer to Plaintiff's Complaint. Accordingly, Plaintiff State of Ohio's Motion for Default Judgment is hereby granted.

Defendant Farthing is hereby ORDERED and ENJOINED to immediately comply with the requirements of Revised Code Chapters 3734 and 3714 and the rules promulgated thereunder.

Defendant Farthing is hereby ORDERED and ENJOINED to immediately the Director's Final Findings and Order's issued June 1, 2001, and immediately remove and properly dispose of all solid wastes at the Farthing Dump Site to a licensed and permitted solid waste facility, and immediately remove and properly dispose of all construction and demolition debris at the Farthing Dump Site to a licensed construction and demolition debris facility and/or a licensed and permitted solid waste facility.

Defendant Farthing is hereby ORDERED and ENJOINED to pay a civil penalty in  
the amount of \$90,000 to the State of Ohio.
