

DSIWM is Reorganizing the Rules

DSIWM has been analyzing how to:

- Make it easier to find requirements
- Make it easier to understand the rules
- Make it easier to be sure what all the requirements are for a given topic
- Make it easier to focus rule changes
- Spread out rule reviews more evenly over time

To accomplish these benefits, DSIWM is planning to reorganize all of its rules. This reorganization includes all rules in the following chapters:

- 3745-27
- 3745-28
- 3745-29
- 3745-30
- 3745-37
- 3745-400

The plan includes:

- A five-year long process to move DSIWM rules, a few at a time, into 3745-500 series for chapter numbers
- Rule chapters to be organized by topic
- Multi-program chapters up front
- Facility chapters organized by the type of waste they handle
- Miscellaneous chapters at the end
- Same types of requirements in the same set of rule numbers in each chapter
- Reduced cross referencing
- Shorter rules will be possible
- Minimize or eliminate sub-sub-sub-sub paragraphs
- Logical order of rules
- Simplified applicability requirements
