PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER
REVISED

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Thomas Lilly., et al. (Defendants) have entered into a proposed Consent Order to resolve the Amended Complaint filed on May 22, 2014 in the Licking County Court of Common Pleas, Case Number 13 CV 1273 against the Defendants for violations of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111, specifically those provisions related to failure to connect to a publicly available and accessible sewer and creating a nuisance. The proposed Consent Order would require the Defendants to immediately comply with the requirements of R.C. Chapter 6111. The proposed Consent Order requires the Defendants to decommission the septic system that serves the apartments at 7755 National Road, Pataskala Ohio and to apply for approval to operate the septic system that serves 7761 National Road, Pataskala, Ohio. In addition, the proposed Consent Order requires the Defendants to pay a civil penalty.

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty (30) day public comment period has expired. The thirty day period commences on **May 7, 2015**. Both the State of Ohio and Thomas Lilly *et al.* reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
