This training will be hands-on with all participants getting in the water to learn techniques for biological, physical and chemical water quality monitoring. Please bring with you: waders or shoes you don't mind getting wet, a brown bag lunch / drink, and wear old clothing. This is an entry level training intended for participants who desire basic water quality information. **Level 1** was designed with educators in mind and may be appropriate for Soil & Water Conservation Districts, Park Districts, Health Departments, or anyone with an interest in Ohio water quality. The purpose of Level 1 is primarily to promote public awareness and education about surface waters of the state.

Approval of Level 1 QDC will be automatic by the Ohio EPA after completion of this training. Metro Parks, Serving Summit County will be our local hosts. There are **no fees** associated with this training.
