Grant Writing 103: Becoming a Grant Reviewer

Want to learn how to write better grants? Compare weak and strong proposals side-by-side and get a funder's perspective on what makes for a winning application. The Ohio Environmental Education Fund (OEEF) will share examples from 20 years of grant making to show why one K-12 education project is more likely to be successful than another, and which proposal is more likely to be funded.

One of the best ways to become a better grant writer yourself is to review others' proposals. Practice scoring online applications, using OEEF's preferred characteristics for projects targeting a pre-school to university audience. Learn about OEEF and the on-line Grants Management System using the eBusiness Center. Participants will be certified as OEEF volunteer peer reviewers. This will be a three hour interactive workshop.
