


# Glass Recycling

## Enhanced Glass Recycling Process

- Container glass recovered through Rumpke commercial and residential programs is first sorted and processed at Rumpke's recycling facility in Columbus. It is one of the most technologically advanced recycling systems in the country, processing nearly 1 million pounds of recyclables per day.
- The sorted glass is then transported to Rumpke's regional glass processing facility in Dayton, Ohio. Enhanced glass recycling technology processes 20,000 tons of broken and mixed glass each year for use in both fiberglass insulation and container glass industries.
- Rumpke partners with several end markets (i.e. manufacturers) to use recovered glass to make new products such as fiberglass insulation and glass containers.
