

Synopsis of Changes to the Following Model General Permit(s) (MGP)

The following model general permits have been administratively modified:

The following term was removed:

A.I.2.d Any paved roadway or parking area that is subsequently paved, will require a General Permit for paved roadways and parking areas.

This term was inadvertently copied into these model general permits from the unpaved roadway and parking area model general permits. The term is erroneous and meaningless.

The Criteria Document was also modified to update the new MGP ID resulting from this administrative modification and to:

- Correct the title of the document from “Model General Permit (MGP) Information Document” to “Model General Permit (MGP) Qualifying Criteria Document.”
- Correct the references in the last paragraph to which answers to the questions should be yes and which should no. Previously it stated the answer should be no for questions 1 through 8 and yes for 9, which is incorrect. The answers should be yes for 1 through 8 and no for 9. This was a copy and paste error.
