

Model General Permit (MGP) Qualifying Criteria Document

Source Description: Paved roadways and parking areas with less than or equal to 70,000 vehicle miles traveled per year and a silt content less than or equal to 12 g/m²

MGP Number: GP6.1

Qualifying Criteria:

Answer the following questions by checking the appropriate box for the choice that describes the equipment for which you are applying for a permit. Then review the qualifying criteria described after the list.

- Yes No 1. Does this facility have paved roadways and parking areas?
- Yes No 2. Has the owner or operator identified in their application an uncontrolled silt content of the paved roads and parking areas of less than or equal to 12 g/m²?
- Yes No 3. Is the owner or operator willing to keep the total vehicles miles traveled (VMT) by all vehicles on the paved roads and parking areas at the facility less than or equal to 70,000 miles?
- Yes No 4. Is the owner or operator willing to keep the mean vehicle weight of all vehicles traveling on the roads and parking areas less than or equal to 30 tons?
- Yes No 5. Does the owner or operator agree the emissions units covered by this general permit can remain in compliance with all terms and conditions of the general permit, including the requirements to employ best available control measures?
- Yes No 6. Does the owner or operator agree to submit a labeled diagram of paved roadways and parking areas at the facility with the application for a general permit?
- Yes No 7. Are the paved roadways and parking areas regulated in any manner under OAC rule 3745-17-12 or OAC rule 3745-17-13?
- Yes No 8. Is the air contaminant source(s) for which this general permit is being sought a part of a new major stationary source or a major modification (see OAC rule 3745-31-01)? If you are unsure, check with the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency.

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If the answer to questions 1 through 6 are yes, and the answer to questions 7 and 8 are no, the facility meets the above "Qualifying Criteria". Otherwise, the facility is not eligible for a general permit and will, instead, need a standard, or traditional, permit. By signing below, the owner or operator's signature shall constitute personal affirmation that the applicant meets the qualifying criteria contained above, and shall subject the signatory to liability under applicable state laws forbidding false or misleading statements.
