

**Public Notice**  
**Availability of Draft Business Impact Analysis for Comment**  
**OAC Chapter 3745-101, "Transportation Conformity"**

Please note that in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 119.032 (5-year rule review), the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-101, "Transportation Conformity." Our review indicates that these rules remain necessary, but are without need of change at this time.

Ohio EPA is currently in the process of replacing the Transportation Conformity Rules in OAC Chapter 3745-101 with a series of memorandums of understanding between Ohio EPA, and affected federal, state, and local agencies. Once the memorandum process has been completed, Ohio EPA anticipates rescinding the rules in this chapter.

As part of the rulemaking process, Ohio EPA is required to prepare and submit a Business Impact Analysis (BIA) form to Ohio's Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office. Ohio EPA is also making this form available at this time for public review and comment.
