

## **RULE SYNOPSIS**

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3750-10-01, 3750-20-70, and 3750-75-05  
SERC/EMA Administrative Rules  
Discussion of Amendments for 5-Year Rule Review

These 3 rules are administrative rules containing definitions, establishing the SERC and its committees, and containing criteria for the placement of lock boxes. These rules were originally filed as No-change rules with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule review (JCARR) on August 21, 2014 to fulfill the requirements of ORC 119.032 (5-year review).

Ohio EPA received a telephone call from the JCARR on September 11, 2014 regarding the 3 rules. As part of their review, JCARR had identified 3 items in these rules that needed to be fixed before they could approve the rules. Ohio EPA is therefore making the following changes in response to the JCARR's request:

1. OAC Rule 3750-10-01: The reference to ORC 2291 in paragraph (A)(4) was a typo and has been corrected to reference ORC 2921. DAPC also made minor updates to reflect current LSC and agency formatting guidelines while the rule was open for amendment.
2. OAC Rule 3750-20-70: DAPC added a comment to the rule containing information on the version and availability of the OHM-EEM document referenced in paragraph (B). DAPC also took the opportunity to rearrange the rule such that the definitions are in alphabetical order. As such, this caused more than 50% change to the rule. Therefore, the rule is being rescinded and proposed new as required by LSC convention.
3. OAC Rule 3750-75-05: The reference to paragraph (B)(6)(a)(iii) of ORC 3750.07 was a typo. The reference has been changed to the same paragraph in ORC 3750.02. DAPC also made several minor changes to update LSC formatting and style issues while the rule was open for amendment.
