Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters has received your application for license to operate a public water system at Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center. I find that the public water system at Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center has not been operated in substantial compliance with Chapter 6109 of the Revised Code and the rules adopted under it. Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center has exceeded the coliform bacteria maximum contaminant level, exceeded the arsenic maximum contaminant level, failed to monitor for contaminants, failed to issue public notices, failed to install treatment or a new water source to address arsenic maximum contaminant level violations, and failed to employ a certified operator. The Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center was previously issued enforcement actions in the form of a Bilateral Compliance Agreement (Effective Date: November 21, 2005) and Director's Final Findings and Orders (Effective Date: May 8, 2008). Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center is in violation of both actions that were issued.


Therefore, pursuant to Section 6109.21(B)(3) of the Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-84-06, I hereby propose to deny your license to operate a public water system at Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center for five (5) years. This case is currently at the Ohio Attorney General's Office for enforcement and a consent order is being drafted. Once a consent order is signed, Ohio EPA may issue a conditional license to operate a public water system to Cochran's Lit-le Lambs Learning Center.

Under Ohio Revised Code Chapters 119 and 6109, this action of the Director will become final on the effective date indicated unless you or an objector requests an adjudication hearing. As provided by Ohio Revised Code Sections 119.07 and 3745.07, a request for an adjudication hearing must be received by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this action. At the adjudication hearing you may appear in person, or be represented by your attorney, or by such representative as is permitted to practice before this Agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing. At the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing against you. The request for hearing shall be in writing and shall specify the issues of fact and law to be contested.
