

The overall goal of the Mound 2000 process is to clean-up the DOE Miamisburg Closure Project to protective (industrial) levels and make it available for economic redevelopment. In order to release portions of the land and buildings as early as possible, a strategy that facilitates its reuse, the Mound property was divided up into parcels, also known as release blocks or phases. Releasing the property by parcels allows redevelopment on a portion of the site while cleanup continues. Release Block D - Record of Decision February 1999 - Transferred March 1999

Release Block D was the first portion of the Department of Energy's Mound Plant to be transferred to the Miamisburg Mound Community Improvement Corporation (MMCIC). This historic event took place in March 1999. Release Block D is comprised of approximately 15 acres and is located in what was once the southeast corner of the developed portion of the original 306 acre Mound Plant.

Release Block H - Record Decision June 1999 - Transferred August 1999

Release Block H is 14 acres in the north corner of the property. Release Block H is bound to the south and west by the plant property and to the north and east by off-site residences.

Parcel 4 - Record of Decision February 2001 - Transferred April 2001

Parcel 4 consists of 94.8 acres mostly used for agricultural purposes prior to the Department of Energy's purchase in 1981. There are no structures or buildings within the parcel. On April 19, 2001, the Miamisburg Mound Community Improvement Corporation (MMCIC) obtained ownership of Miamisburg Closure Project 's Parcel 4, or the "South Property".

Parcel 3 - Record of Decision 2001 - Transferred August 2002

Parcel 3 is a relatively small area area of land and buildings located at the northern boundary of the Mound facility.

Phase 1 - Record of Decision July 2003

Phase I consists of 51.6 acres of land, approximately 17% of the original 306 acres making up the Mound Plant. Phase I lies on the southern border of the plant and is made up of three distinct sections of the site property. Phase I represents the fifth parcel of land made available for transferred to the Miamisburg Mound Community Improvement Corporation (MMCIC) from the Department of Energy Mound Plant.

Parcels 6, 7, and 8

The Record of Decision is scheduled to be completed in 2009. Transfer of the property should follow soon after the completion of the ROD. Parcels 6, 7, and 8 consist of 103 acres located in the middle of property. There are 10 structures and 332 Potential Release Sites in Parcels 6, 7, and 8. The parcels contained the major production and waste handling areas of the plant.
