History of use:	The property was originally utilized as a dairy farm until approximately the late 1920s. From the late 1920s to 1946, portions of the site were mined for sand and gravel. The resulting pits were then utilized for the disposal of domestic and industrial wastes until 1977. From 1980 to 1983, the site was used for the disposal of wastewater grit from the City of Cincinnati Metropolitan Sewer District Wastewater Treatment Plant, and also for the disposal of construction and demolition debris. For a short period, a portion of the site was used for recreational ball fields.
