History of use:	The property had previously been used as a steel mill and a slag plant. The majority of the property was used by Empire-Detroit Steel Mill, and later Cyclops Corporation as a steel mill. The mill permanently shut down in 1980, but the underground coke oven gas transmission line was in operation until the Coke Plant (located on a different NFA letter) shut down operation on April 2, 2002.
