

The Master Sites List

The Master Sites List (MSL) was created in 1988 for the listing, tracking and reporting of potentially contaminated sites in Ohio managed by DERR. It listed sites where there was evidence of, or it was suspected that there was, contamination of air, water or soil, and there was a confirmed or potential threat to human health or to the environment.
