

How to find brokers who are licensed to sell Environmental Insurance in Ohio

Not all insurance brokers or insurance agents are licensed to sell environmental insurance. An insurance broker or agent must be licensed to sell what is known in the insurance industry as **Surplus Lines** of insurance.

The Ohio Department of Insurance maintains lists of both in-state (resident) and out-of-state (non-resident) agents and brokers who are currently licensed to sell Surplus Lines in Ohio. In order to access these lists, follow the instructions below:

- ❖ Log onto the Agent/Agency section of the Ohio Dept. of Insurance Web site at:

- ❖ Under the “Agent License Type” drop down menu select either “Resident Surplus Line Agent” or “Non-Res. Surplus Line Agent” and then hit search. Conducting both the Resident and Non-Resident searches will provide you with the names and contact information for all the agents and brokers licensed to sell Environmental Insurance in the state of Ohio.
