

- QUESTION:** What are the various response requirements for ground water in voluntary actions?
- BACKGROUND:** The following flow charts have been developed to aid Volunteers in determining appropriate response requirements for ground water. Past versions of OAC 3745-300-10 included versions of these flow charts to guide volunteers through rule requirements. The flow charts were removed from the 2009 rules and included in this guidance to comply with Joint Committee on Rule Review requirements.
- ANSWER:** Ground water response requirement flow charts have been updated and included in this guidance for use at voluntary action properties. The flow charts explain the ground water classification and ground water response requirements in rule OAC 3745-300-10. The first flow chart depicts the process for classifying ground water. The classification of ground water underlying the property, in some situations, may be determined without answering every question presented in the flow chart. It is important to note that this flow chart does not present all criteria and requirements that may be necessary to properly classify the ground water. Refer to paragraphs (A) and (B) of rule 3745-300-10 and paragraphs (F)(6) through (F)(8) of rule 3745-300-07 for applicable portions of the rules for classifying ground water. The second flow chart depicts which response requirements apply to ground water based upon its classification and whether or not the property is within an urban setting designation. The flow charts are provided as guidance only and may not be relied on to determine applicable standards for the property.
