Dear Ms. Beringer:

On January 17, 2012, Ohio EPA received a request for a Class 1A (Class 1 requiring prior approval) hazardous waste permit modification (**tracking number – 1201117-1A-1**) dated January 12, 2012 from Heritage-WTI (WTI). With this letter, Ohio EPA approves the above referenced Class 1A modification submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51.

FOR APPROVAL:

There have been no modifications to the WTI Part B permit application.

The following modification has been made to your March 23, 2005 Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit:

Modify B.2(a) on Page 18a – to modify Condition B.2(a) to reflect a change in the regulations. On September 10, 2010, OAC 3745-54-12 was revised to require the regulated facility to submit advance notices of waste imports to the USEPA regional administrator, rather than the Director of Ohio EPA.

The affected permit page is modified in the upper left corner of the page to indicate the date the Class 1A modification request was received by Ohio EPA. The permit page is date-stamped with the effective date of this letter.

*Also, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-50-51(D)(1)(a)(ii), the Permittee must send a notice within 90 days of an approved Class 1A Modification to all persons on the Agency mailing list. An updated mailing list can be obtained by contacting Jeri Savelle, Authorizing Actions & Engineering Unit at (614) 644-2944, or by e-mail at jeri.savelle@epa.state.oh.us.

- (e) The Permittee may receive and store off-site generated waste (third party waste) that will not be incinerated at the facility. This waste will be transported off-site to a permitted facility for treatment and/or reclamation. Third party waste will be managed in accordance with this permit and the approved Part B permit application.
- (f) The Permittee may manage mixed infectious and hazardous waste (MIHW) in accordance with the specifications in the Part B permit application and Module I(B) of this permit.
- (g) The Permittee may receive and treat, but not store, approved compressed gas waste streams as listed in Section C, Waste Characteristic and Waste Analysis Plan. The compressed gases will be managed in accordance with this permit and the approved Part B permit application.

B.2. Required Notices
OAC Rule 3745-54-12

- (a) The Permittee shall notify the US EPA Regional Administrator in writing at least four weeks in advance of the date the Permittee expects to receive hazardous waste from a foreign source, as required by OAC Rule 3745-54-12(A). Notice of subsequent shipments of the same waste from the same foreign source is not required.
