

(A) The owner or operator of an industrial facility shall provide notice to the parties listed in paragraph (B) of this rule by certified mail or any other form of mail accompanied by a receipt not less than ninety days prior to the anticipated date on which the industrial facility will cease to accept industrial waste if closure is required under any of the following:

- (1) Paragraph (A)(1) or (B)(1) of rule 3745-525-710 of the Administrative Code.
- (2) Paragraph (A)(2) or (B)(2) of rule 3745-525-710 of the Administrative Code.
- (3) Paragraph (A)(3) or (B)(3) of rule 3745-525-710 of the Administrative Code.

(B) The owner or operator shall send the written notification required in paragraph (A) of this rule to the following:

- (1) Ohio EPA.
- (2) For an industrial solid waste landfill, the approved board of health of the health district in which the industrial solid waste landfill is located.
- (3) For an industrial solid waste landfill, the single or joint county solid waste management district in which the industrial solid waste landfill is located.

(C) Concurrently with the submission of the notice required by paragraph (A) of this rule, the owner or operator shall commence publishing, at three-week intervals, prominent notice of the anticipated date on which industrial waste will cease to be accepted at the industrial facility. Such notice shall be published in the county in which the industrial facility is located and in each county which has been a source of at least twenty-five per cent of the wastes deposited at the industrial facility over the previous twelve months of operation. Upon request by Ohio EPA, the owner or operator shall provide documentation to Ohio EPA that demonstrates that the notices required by this paragraph have been published as required by this paragraph. The owner or operator of an industrial solid waste landfill shall also send such documentation to the approved board of health upon request by the approved board of health. This paragraph shall not apply to an industrial facility owned by a generator that is used exclusively to dispose of wastes generated at premises owned by the generator.

(D) Not later than seven days after the date the owner or operator of the industrial facility ceased acceptance of waste, the owner or operator shall send notification by certified mail or any other form of mail accompanied by a receipt to Ohio EPA. The owner or operator of an industrial solid waste landfill shall concurrently send the notification to the approved board of health. Such notification shall include the following information:

- (1) The actual date that the industrial facility ceased to accept waste.

(2) The name, address, and telephone number of the person or office to contact regarding the industrial facility during the closure and post-closure care periods.
