Summary of the Applicability of OAC Chapter 3745-520 “Regulation of New Construction and Demolition Debris Facilities”

Does Chapter 3745-520 “Regulation of New Construction and Demolition Debris Facilities” apply to me?

- OAC Chapter 3745-520 DOES NOT APPLY to an existing C&DD facility that will be filled up and closed without expanding the existing facility boundary or existing disposal limits.
OAC Chapter 3745-520 DOES APPLY to an owner or operator of a “new C&DD facility”; the statutory term “new C&DD facility” includes a proposed C&DD facility that has never existed before and an existing C&DD facility where the owner or operator wants to expand the facility.

When does OAC 3745-520 become applicable?

- There is no call-in schedule. An owner or operator determines when OAC Chapter 3745-520 applies by making a decision to create a new C&DD facility (this includes expanding an existing facility).
As required by statute, before anyone can establish a new C&DD facility, a permit to install is required. The requirements for obtaining a permit to install for a new C&DD facility are found in OAC Chapter 3745-520.
Once a permit to install for a new C&DD facility is issued, from then on the facility is regulated by OAC Chapter 3745-520.
