An overview of Ohio's C&DD Ground Water Monitoring Program, including the evaluation of potential releases of C&DD-derived constituents to ground water and adequacy of the ground water monitoring networks at C&DD Facilities in Ohio.

- 1:25 **Ohio EPA Electronic Licensing and Registration Tools**, *Paula Canter and Holly Hillyer*
This session will provide an overview of the eBusiness Center's electronic licensing software that Ohio EPA will be implementing for health district use for the 2014 licensing cycle. Topics include how to get started in the eBusiness Center, the roles and responsibilities of the users, and how to process license applications using the software. A preview of a compliance module to record inspections and violations will also be provided.

In 2012, the C&DD rules were amended to require itemized costs for activities associated with closure and post-closure care of C&DD facilities. As a result, C&DD facility owners may submit an environmental covenant to lessen certain costs. This session will provide an overview of the rule requirements, as well as an introduction to environmental covenants and the procedure that will be used by Ohio EPA when issuing covenants.
