Beneficial Use Authorization

Pursuant to Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), the Director of Environmental Protection hereby makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders.

FINDINGS

1. A&L Salvage, Inc. Construction and Demolition Debris (C&DD) Facility (Facility) is a C&DD landfill located at 11225 State Route 45, Lisbon, in Columbiana County, Ohio. A&L Salvage, Inc. is the operator and licensee of the Facility which is licensed and regulated by the Columbiana County Board of Health.
2. A&L Salvage, Inc. proposes to use 63,900 cubic yards of shredded tires to construct a one foot drainage layer in a 39.6 acre C&DD disposal cell. The cell construction will occur over a period of five years and A&L Salvage, Inc. will not exceed 20,000 cubic yards of storage of tire shreds at the Facility at any one time.
3. Beneficial use of shredded scrap tires as a construction material in a C&DD landfill's leachate collection system requires approval in the license, requires a project plan to be submitted to Ohio EPA, and requires the director's authorization granted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-78(F), prior to project implementation. On February 8, 2001, Ohio EPA received a project plan pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-78 from A&L Salvage, Inc.
4. OAC Rule 3745-27-78(J) sets forth the criteria for approval of scrap tire beneficial use project plans.
5. Based on the information submitted in the applicant's project proposal, as described in Finding No. 3, I have determined that the project plan meets the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-78(J) and will not create a nuisance or a hazard to the public health or safety or the environment;



ORDERS

1. Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-78(F), A&L Salvage, Inc. is hereby authorized to beneficially use shredded scrap tires at the Facility in accordance with these Orders and the beneficial use plan as described in Finding No. 3. In addition, A&L Salvage, Inc. is authorized to temporarily store shredded scrap tires in accordance with this project plan and the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-78(C). The shredded scrap tire stockpiles shall be located at the Facility.
2. A&L Salvage, Inc. shall submit a modification request to the Columbiana County Health Department requesting the health department to modify the Facility C&DD license to reflect the specifications and information provided by the applicant in this request. A&L Salvage, Inc. shall not implement the project before receiving written concurrence from the Columbiana County Health Department.
3. The temporary storage of shredded scrap tires at the Facility prior to beneficial use must be conducted in accordance with **OAC** Rule 3745-27-60 and shall not exceed 20,000 cubic yards of tire shreds at any one time.
4. Not later than 14 days after completion of the beneficial use project, any shredded scrap tires not used in the project shall be removed and properly disposed of in a licensed scrap tire disposal facility or another approved beneficial use site.
5. These orders shall expire on December 31, 2004. This approval may be extended for up to two additional years by notifying the Northeast District Office/DSIWM in writing and obtaining written concurrence from Ohio EPA.
6. A&L Salvage, Inc. shall comply with OAC Rule 3745-27-78(H) by assisting scrap tire transporter(s) in the completion of shipping papers and with OAC Rule 3745-27-57(E) by retaining a copy of the shipping paper for three years.
7. A&L Salvage, Inc. shall submit scrap tire annual reports in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-65(J)(3) and a final report as required by OAC Rule 3745-27-78(H)(5). The scrap tire annual report shall list two separate quantities: (1) the total quantity of scrap tire material delivered to the Facility during the past calendar year; and (2) the total quantity of scrap tire material beneficially used during the past calendar year.
8. All shipping papers, log entries, and scrap tire annual report information concerning scrap tires and scrap tire material delivered to A&L Salvage C&DD Landfill shall list **Beneficial Use Project Plan Number 15-STBU-1054.**

9. Nothing in these Orders shall be construed to authorize any waiver or variance from any other requirements of applicable state solid waste laws or regulations except as specified herein. These Orders shall not be interpreted to release A&L Salvage, Inc. from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3434, or 61'11 of the Ohio Revised Code; the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants from the Facility to the environment.
