Re: Hodapp Landfill, Butler County
Compliance Monitoring Plan Approval

Dear Mr. Richardson:

The Hodapp Landfill is a closed solid waste disposal facility located in Butler County. By correspondence dated May 20, 2002, the landfill's owner - International Paper - submitted a Compliance Monitoring Plan (Plan) for approval in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(E)(7) in lieu of a corrective measures study.

OAC Rule 3745-30-08(E)(7) states, in part:

"If the permittee determines ... that leachate or leachate-derived constituents from the facility have entered the ground water, then the permittee may, prior to meeting the requirements of paragraph (F) of this rule [Corrective Measures Study], request that the director approve a compliance monitoring program at the facility."

Based on ground water monitoring, arsenic, barium, and manganese from the facility have entered the ground water. Upon review of the submitted Plan, the proposed compliance trigger levels for the above constituents are reasonable and justified. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-30-08(E)(7), I hereby approve the Compliance Monitoring Plan, as submitted on May 20, 2002, for the closed Hodapp Landfill.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases above the trigger levels for those constituents established under OAC Rule 3745-30-08(E)(7)(b) and the approved Compliance Monitoring Plan which are detected and confirmed, the owner shall submit a corrective measures study to the director in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-30-08(F).

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio

Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the commission within 30 days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three days after the appeal is filed with the commission.
