**Re: Grayton Road Landfill, Cuyahoga County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-13 Change Request**

Dear Mr. Mok:

On October 22, 2002, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Northeast District Office (NEDO) received a document titled *Response to Ohio EPA Request for Additional Information for Modifying the Rule 13 Work Plan, Grayton Road Landfill, Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, Cleveland, Ohio*, dated October 18, 2002, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-13. The document requests changes to the OAC Rule 3745-27-13 authorization for the Grayton Road Landfill issued November 26, 2001. The document was prepared and submitted by the City of Cleveland Department of Port Control (CDPC). The November 26, 2001, approval authorized an airport expansion and stockpile relocation over a portion of the Grayton Road Landfill. The landfill is owned by CDPC, and was operated from 1975 to 1977. The Grayton Road Landfill is located in the City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County.

The October 18, 2002, request specifically proposes to reduce the area to be disturbed, authorized in the November 26, 2001, approval. Specific activities authorized in the November 26, 2001, approval included relocation of a soil stockpile, known as the Area 6 Stockpile/Stockpile E, construction of an airport perimeter road, installation of a culvert over Abram Creek, and the filling of a ravine area. Due to changes in project scope, a smaller portion of the Area 6 Stockpile/Stockpile E will require relocation, and remaining portions of Area 6 Stockpile/Stockpile E are now proposed to remain undisturbed.

Both authorized and requested activities will occur on a portion of the Grayton Road Landfill pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-13. Engineering controls authorized by the November 26, 2001, approval for work conducted within the limits of waste placement will remain unchanged. Ohio EPA has reviewed the request to ensure compliance with the November 26, 2001, authorization as modified by other authorizing documents, and all

applicable regulations contained within OAC Chapter 3745-27. Based on this review, I hereby approve the proposed changes specified in the October 18, 2002, request.

This approval only authorizes specific activities at the Grayton Road Landfill in accordance with the November 26, 2001, authorization, as modified by the document titled *Response to Ohio EPA Request for Additional Information for Modifying the Rule 13 Work Plan, Grayton Road Landfill, Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, Cleveland, Ohio, October 18, 2002*. All activities must be conducted in accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the request. There may be no deviation from the approved plans without the express, written, authorization of Ohio EPA. Any future activities may require additional Ohio EPA approval.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from any requirements of applicable state solid waste laws or regulations. This authorization shall not be interpreted to release CDPC or others from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Toxic Substances Control Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants from the facility to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission.
