



PTI SUMMARY

This permit approval (PTI Number 02-18548) authorizes Republic Waste Services of Ohio II, LLC (Republic) to increase the authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) of its Countywide Recycling and Disposal Facility (Facility) located in Stark County. The previously 7,000-ton AMDWR was established in PTI Number 02-14694 issued on April 19, 2001. Republic proposes to increase the AMDWR to 7,800 tons through this permit approval. Based on the new AMDWR, the facility's currently approved limits of waste placement will provide approximately 23.6 years of operation.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, this permit approval.

PTI CONDITIONS

1. The director, or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal facility).
2. The proposed source shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the application for this permit to the director. There may be no deviation from the approved plans without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved plans or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed facilities will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste disposal facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.
3. Issuance of this permit approval does not relieve Republic of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit approval shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI application Number 02-18548, received on September 10, 2003, and revised on September 23, 2003.

5. The Facility's AMDWR is hereby established to be 7,800 tons. This supersedes any previously established AMDWR for the facility. This approval shall apply only to the increase in the facility's AMDWR.
6. This permit approval may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal facility.
7. The owner or operator shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the municipal solid waste disposal facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
8. Nothing in this permit approval shall be interpreted to release Republic from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable laws for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
9. Unless specifically superseded by this permit approval, Republic shall comply with the requirements of all authorizing documents issued prior to this permit approval.
10. Pursuant to paragraphs (Q) and (V) of ORC Section 3745.11, payment of the solid waste permit-to-install fee balance, in the amount of \$600.00 payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio", shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn: Fiscal Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049. The fee balance shall be submitted within 30 days of the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance with paragraphs (Q) and (V) of ORC Section 3745.11.
