Dear Mr. Carlson:

In a letter dated December 21, 2004, and received on December 27, 2004, Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC submitted a request to decrease the Authorized Maximum Daily Waste Receipt (AMDWR) at the Pilot Project Scrap Tire Monofill. The Pilot Project Scrap Tire Monofill is located in Minerva, Stark County, Ohio.

The Pilot Project Scrap Tire Monofill's current AMDWR of five hundred (500) tons of scrap tires was established by Director's Findings and Orders dated March 20, 1995.

Upon review of your request, I have determined that granting decrease in the AMDWR at the Pilot Project Scrap Tire Monofill will not create a nuisance or a hazard to public health or safety or the environment. You are hereby authorized to decrease the authorized maximum daily waste receipt at the Pilot Project Scrap Tire Monofill from five hundred (500) tons to one hundred (100) tons per day.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the Entity from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Acts for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the commission within 30 days after notice of the director's action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three days after the appeal is filed with the commission. An appeal may be filed with the commission at the following address:
