Dear Mr. Kostelnick:

On February 18, 2005, Eagon & Associates, Inc. submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) a request, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c)(ii), to continue detection monitoring for sodium in monitoring well BW-12 at the Noble Road Landfill.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c)(ii), the owner or operator may demonstrate that a source other than the facility caused the contamination, or the increase resulted from error during sampling, analysis, or statistical evaluation, or natural variation in the groundwater. The February 18, 2005, demonstration concluded that the statistically significant increase of sodium in monitoring well BW-12 is not the result of a release from the landfill.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c)(ii), I hereby approve this demonstration and the owner/operator of the Noble Road Landfill may continue ground water detection monitoring in monitoring well BW-12.

A detailed account of Ohio EPA's review of the ground water demonstration will be sent to you under separate cover.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water quality for any parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E), or obtain similar approval to remain in detection monitoring.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director of environmental protection within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission.
