**Re: Noble Rd. Landfill, Richland County
Decline to Approve Alternate Monitoring Parameter List**

Dear Mr. Kostelnick:

On February 17, 2005, Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of the Noble Road Landfill, Inc., submitted a request to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) to establish an alternate monitoring parameter list in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2) at the Noble Road Landfill located in Richland County.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2), the owner or operator of a sanitary landfill may propose to delete any of the Appendix I monitoring parameters to be used to meet the requirements of paragraphs (D)(5) to (D)(8) of that rule. The Director of Ohio EPA (Director) may approve the reduced list if the removed parameters are not reasonably expected to be in or derived from the waste contained or deposited in the landfill.

The request proposes to remove 40 of 66 lab-analyzed appendix I statistical parameters and presented laboratory results for leachate samples, time series graphs, a list of volatile organic compound detections, and a list of leachate sampling results indicating that these parameters were not detected above the practical quantitation limits (PQL) as listed on the laboratory reports.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the request to establish an alternate monitoring parameter list and does not concur that the monitoring parameters proposed for removal in the request are not reasonably expected to be in or derived from the waste contained or deposited at the facility. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2), I hereby decline to authorize Noble Road Landfill, Inc. to establish an alternate monitoring parameter list.
