**Re: Rumpke Sanitary Landfill, Hamilton County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(F)(16) Approval**

Dear Mr. Butler:

On December 27, 2000, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received a document titled "A Corrective Measures Plan MW-15S Assessment Area," dated December 21, 2000, for the Rumpke Sanitary Landfill (Facility), located in Hamilton County. The document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of Rumpke Sanitary Landfill, Inc. Final revisions to this document were received by Ohio EPA on February 26, 2001. According to the document, analysis of the ground water detection monitoring data indicated that the following statistically significant changes were detected: Beta-bhc, dinoseb and 1,3-dichlorobenzene in monitoring well MW-15S. On June 12, 2001, the Director of Ohio EPA selected a corrective measure to address the ground water exceedances observed in monitoring well MW-15S.

On November 6, 2006, Ohio EPA, DSIWM, SWDO, received a document titled "A 2006 Second Semiannual MW-15S Corrective Measures Activities Report," dated October 26, 2006, for the Facility. This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of Rumpke Sanitary Landfill Inc., pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10 (F)(15). On December 4, 2006, Ohio EPA, DSIWM, SWDO received a certification report stating that the corrective measures related to monitoring well MW-15S assessment have been completed in compliance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(15).

Ohio EPA has reviewed both the November 6, and December 4, 2006 information and the certification report, and, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(16), I hereby approve the certification. Therefore, the Facility shall be released from the requirement to maintain financial assurance requirements for the above described corrective measures pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-18.

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You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
