Proposed Alternate Parameter Monitoring List**

Dear Mr. Gallagher:

On January 26, 2001, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO), received a report from Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of Waste Management of Ohio. This report requested an alternate groundwater monitoring list for the Coshocton Landfill, Inc. pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-27-10(D)(2). Your request is based on the fact that analyses of the annual leachate and previous ground water samples collected at the site have not detected any of the Appendix I parameters noted in your request. Representatives from the Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) and DSIWM have reviewed the aforementioned document.

Based upon a review of the leachate data presented to Ohio EPA the following alternate list of Appendix I inorganic indicator parameters and volatile organic compounds (VOC's) is hereby approved pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2) for a period of one year. The Coshocton Landfill, Inc. may request another alternate parameter list at that time. If another alternate list is not approved, Coshocton Landfill shall resume monitoring in accordance with OAC 3745-27-1,0(D)(1).

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
