Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-13 Authorization**

Dear Mr. Jones:

By letter dated April 5, 2001, with subsequent submittals dated April 10, 2001; May 29, 2001; and July 6, 2001, Hull & Associates, acting on behalf of the City of Rossford, requested to perform construction activities at the closed Wales Road Landfill. The request was made in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-13.

The information provided by Hull & Associates has been reviewed by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and found to be complete and in accordance with the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-13(C).

Based upon the information you have provided, I have determined, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-13(F), that the proposed construction activities will not result in a violation of applicable laws and regulations administered by the director, will not create a nuisance, and are unlikely to adversely affect the public health and safety and the environment. Therefore, I hereby authorize the City of Rossford to undertake the tasks provided within the Request for 3745-27-13 Authorization for construction activities at the closed Wales Road Landfill with the following conditions:

1. Not later than 90 days after completion of the activities approved under this authorization, a certification report shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office (NWDO) which demonstrates that the project was performed in accordance with this authorization, and the submitted plans and specifications.
2. A leachate report, documenting the total volume of leachate pumped each month, shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, NWDO in accordance with the following schedule:
 - a. Once the activities approved under this authorization are completed, the report shall be submitted at the beginning of the next immediate quarter, and each quarter thereafter for a period of two years.
 - b. After the two-year period has ended, the report shall be submitted annually.

3. Ohio EPA, NWDO shall be notified at least three days before initiation of any on-site activities.
4. If leachate outbreaks persist after this remediation effort, additional remediation must be performed. If additional remediation efforts include filling, grading, excavating, drilling, building, or mining, then an additional authorization, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-13, will be required.
5. The high level alarm for the leachate storage tank shall consist of a flashing light indicating that the leachate tank is at 90% capacity. The tank must be emptied within 24 hours after the alarm is activated. The date and time of when the alarm is activated and when the tank is emptied shall be documented and submitted as part of the leachate report specified in Condition Number 2, above.
6. Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-13(J), this authorization may be revoked if the authorized activities result in violation, or are likely to violate, any applicable laws, or if continued implementation of the authorized activities causes a threat to human health or safety or the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the commission within 30 days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three days after the appeal is filed with the commission.
