Ohio EPA Drafts Licensing Rules

The Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM) has conducted a review of the rules governing the licensing of solid waste, infectious waste, and construction and demolition debris facilities. This review is being conducted to satisfy requirements mandated by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 119.032 which requires all state agencies to review each of their rules every five years to determine whether or not to continue the rules without change, amend the rules, or rescind the rules. An earlier draft of proposed rule changes was sent to Interested Parties in March 2002. In response to internal Agency comments and those comments submitted by Interested Parties, the DSIWM has drafted new language.
