## **New Requirements for Class III / Class IV Compost Facilities**

Submittal of an annual report by Class III and Class IV facilities is a new requirement pursuant to the new composting rules that became effective on June 1, 2003. The new rules also require Class IV facilities to maintain a daily log of operations, which contains all the information needed to complete the annual report. Similarly, a Class III facility operator should find all the information needed in the facility's daily log of operation.

If your facility was newly registered last year, only complete the information for the months after registration. Since the new requirements became effective June 1, 2003, many Class IV facilities will not have information available for the whole year. At this time, Ohio EPA ask operators to submit any information available for the year.

The annual report form shall be completed and submitted to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office and your local health district (only if you are in an approved health district). **Completed forms must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2004.**
