## RELEASE OF RFB FOR WORK AT THE KIRBY SCRAP TIRE SITE

Ohio EPA has released the Request for Bids (RFB) pertaining to scrap tire removal work at the Kirby site at 3137 State Highway 231, Sycamore, Ohio (Wyandot County). The Kirby RFB was mailed on January 12, 2004, to those companies responding to the announcement on Ohio EPA's Web site or the December 10, 2003, letter announcing the pending release of the RFB. The period of performance will be fifteen (15) months from April 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005, to remove 3,750,000 passenger tire equivalents (37,500 tons) and up to 7,500 tons of associated solid waste.
