

Ohio EPA Refiles Miscellaneous Landfill Rules

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Sections 3734.02, 3734.041 and 3734.12 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to refile the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code. The rules were originally filed on March 22, 2002 and then placed under Intent to Refile in order to further review and make any necessary revisions based on comments received at the April 24, 2002 public hearing and during the comment period. Rule 3745-27-01 (New) Definitions:

- Deleted the proposed revisions to the term "aquifer system", and removed the definition of "fund". The definitions for "final slope", "interim slope", and "internal slope" were moved from another proposed rule (where they were available for public comment). The definition of "internal slope" was also revised grammatically. The definition of "biodegradable containers" was also revised to provide greater flexibility with the requirement for the "Compostable Logo". Also the reference in "current final closure cost estimate " was corrected from 3745-27-25 to 3745-27-24.

Rule 3745-27-05 (New) Applicability and relations to other laws:

- Minor editing clarifications were made from the previously filed version. Paragraph (A)(4)(c)(i) was revised to provide more flexibility.

Rule 3745-27-12 (New) Explosive gas migration monitoring for a sanitary landfill facility:

- A typographical error was corrected in (A)(3). Added a second zone, defined by a locus of points extending outward two hundred feet from the limits of waste placement to (D)(2)(a)(ii). Clarified when punch bars may be used to monitor gas migration in occupied structures in (D)(5)(a)(i)(c) and (D)(5)(a)(ii)(b). Made a cross reference correction in (E)(1)(c).

Rule 3745-27-13 (New) Procedure to engage in filling, grading, excavating, building, drilling, or mining on land where a hazardous waste facility or solid waste facility was operated:

- (G)(3)(f) has been revised to no longer require the submission of sampling or testing results.
