Required for Ohio EPA complete application:

- A complete 401 WQC application form; Submit 3 copies of the application package;
- A copy of the United States Army Corps of Engineers' jurisdictional determination letter;
- If the project impacts a wetland, the results of a wetland evaluation method acceptable to the director (i.e. ORAM 5.0) and the proposed category assignment;
- If the project impacts a stream for which a specific aquatic life use designation has not been made, a use attainability analysis;
- A specific and detailed mitigation proposal, including the location and proposed legal mechanism for protecting the property in perpetuity;
- Applicable permit fees (Reference - <http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dsw/401/fees.aspx>);
- Site photographs;
- Adequate documentation confirming that the applicant has requested comments from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and the United States Fish & Wildlife Service regarding threatened and endangered species, including the presence or absence of critical habitat;
- Descriptions, schematics, and appropriate economic information of the applicant's preferred alternative, non-degradation alternatives and minimal degradation alternatives for design and operation of the activity;
- The applicant's investigation report of the waters of the United States in support of the 404 permit application; and
- A copy of the United States Army Corps of Engineers' public notice regarding the 404-permit application. If no public notice is to be issued by the Corps, notification that the project is to be authorized under a general permit will fulfill this requirement.
- Optional:** Draft Public Notice, Notice of Receipt of 401 Application (Reference: <http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dsw/401/publicnotice.aspx>).
