PUBLIC NOTICE  
PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) has entered into a proposed Consent Order with William Walker Sr., et al., d.b.a. Hillview Mobile Home Park (Defendant), to resolve all claims alleged in the complaint filed by the State of Ohio, Stark County Court of Common Pleas case number 08-CV-5100. The proposed Consent Order requires the Defendant to comply with all applicable provisions of Ohio's Water Pollution Control Law, R.C. Chapter 6111 and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and the terms and conditions of any permit, license, or plan approval that may be issued to the Defendant. The proposed Consent Order also requires that the Defendant immediately refrain from making changes to Hillview's Wastewater Treatment Works ("WWTW") until a Permit to Install application for such a change has been submitted and approved by the Director. Defendant shall bring or maintain the WWTW in full compliance with the terms and conditions of Exhibit A until Hillview's WWTW is tied into the Village of Brewster's ("Village") Publicly Owned Treatment Works. By September 1, 2010, Defendant shall submit a fully signed legally binding Agreement and Declaration of Covenants for Extension of Village Sewer Services. Defendant also shall connect their WWTW into the Village's Publicly Owned Treatment Works by no later than 60 days after the Village notifies them in writing that it is available and abandon their WWTW by no later than 30 days thereafter. Further, Defendant shall also immediately hire and/or retain an operator of record who holds a valid Class I Wastewater Works Operator Certificate until such time as Hillview's WWTW is connected to the Village's Publicly Owned Treatment Works. Finally, the proposed Consent Order requires payment of a thirty thousand dollar (\$30,000.00) civil penalty.

Written comments should be submitted to Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office at the above address. Written Comments should be submitted **on or before July 13, 2010.**

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty (30) day public comment period has expired. The thirty day period commences **on June 14, 2010.** Both the State of Ohio and William Walker, Sr., et al., d.b.a. Hillview Mobile Home Park reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
